Professor Offers Prescription for California's San Joaquin Delta

SAN LUIS OBISPO -- Professor Charles Burt, Director of Cal Poly's Irrigation Training and Research Center, wrote a guest column published in the Sacramento Bee Sunday, Aug. 30. Burt, an international expert on irrigation issues and techniques, outlined problems facing the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta. "What does it mean to restore health to the Delta?" he asked.

Burt is a professor of Bioresources and Agriculture Engineering in Cal Poly's College of Agriculture, Food and Environmental Sciences (CAFES). He is also an international consultant on irrigation and water management. He received the university's first Distinguished Teaching Award in 2004 for his leadership and exemplary accomplishments related to irrigation, canal modernization, and efficiency in the use of water resources.
