Cal Poly Music Ensembles to Give Benefit Chamber Concert at Mission Feb. 6

SAN LUIS OBISPO - Several of Cal Poly's finest student music ensembles will perform traditional and contemporary chamber music at 8 p.m. Saturday, Feb. 6 in the Old Mission Church in San Luis Obispo.

"A Night at the Mission" will include performances by the Wind Quintets, Wind Dectet, Saxophone Quartets, Trombone Choir, Clarinet Quartet, String Quintet, Brass Quintet and Brass Ensemble. The event will help raise funds for more than 60 student-musicians to perform at the Walt Disney Concert Hall during the 2010 Los Angeles International Music Festival in June.
