The Met: Live In HD Screening of "Faust" January 15

The MET: Live in HD screening series continues in the new year with an encore engagement of Charles Gounod's riveting dramatic opera, FAUST, Sunday, January 15, 2012 at 2 p.m. at the Performing Arts Center's Cohan Center.

The local HD screening of New York City's Metropolitan Opera's December production begins at 2 p.m. and runs approximately 3 hours and 40 minutes, with two intermissions.

With Jonas Kaufmann in the title role, René Pape as the Devil, and Marina Poplavskaya as Marguerite, Gounod's classic re-telling of the Faust legend couldn't be better served. Tony Award-winning director Des McAnuff updates the story to the first half of the 20th century with a production that won praise in London last season.

The Met: Live in HD is the Metropolitan Opera's Peabody and Emmy Award-winning series of performances transmitted live by satellite in high-definition to more than 1400 movie theaters around the world.

Opera stars such as Fleming, Natalie Dessay, Plácido Domingo, Susan Graham, Thomas Hampson, and Deborah Voigt have served as hosts for the shows, conducting live interviews with cast and crew and introducing behind-the-scenes features - allowing the worldwide HD audience an unprecedented look at what goes into the staging of an opera at one of the world's great houses. Robotic cameras and state-of-the-art technology are used to capture the action, giving a bird's-eye view and interesting perspectives on the productions.

In order to offer the The Met: Live in HD series, the Performing Arts Center underwent major technological renovations in 2010, including the installation of a new 22,000 lumen projector with high-definition capabilities. The purchase of the new equipment was made possible by the Foundation for the Performing Arts Center through a generous donation by the Hind Foundation.
