"Young Frankenstein" is Now a Monster-Ously Marvelous Musical

SAN LUIS OBISPO, CALIFORNIA – Central Coast patrons, beware! Frankenstein's monster lives! Mel Brooks' YOUNG FRANKENSTEIN is a new musical comedy from the creative team of the 12-time Tony Award-winning smash, The Producers, and it's coming to town for two hilarious performances!
