
University Advancement Presentation by Bill Boldt: Five questions were presented to Dr. Boldt prior to today's meeting for his preparation and response. The five questions he was asked to speak on were:

1. The role and structure of University Advancement
2. The University Advancement budget
3. Benefits to the university's instructional programs
4. Benefit/Cost Ratio
5. The Centennial Campaign

University Advancement is in charge of raising private support for Cal Poly through its fundraising process. Between 1995/96 and 1997/98, total gifts have increased from \$12,140,239 to \$23,167,300. To receive a gift from a donor, the gift must meet a need (it can't be obsolete), the college must approve the gift, and it cannot be a hazardous waste or risk. A brief presentation on the Centennial Campaign was also given.
