#3 Cal Poly vs. #8 Weber State, Sat., **Nov. 29**, 6 p.m., Alex G. Spanos Stadium

Cal Poly (8-2 overall, 3-0 Great West), which for the first time in five seasons won seven straight games before falling in overtime to Wisconsin last week, begins its second Football Championship Subdivision playoff drive Saturday night, hosting Big Sky Conference co-champion Weber State (9-3, 7-1 Big Sky).

The seventh meeting between the two schools is scheduled for a 6:05 p.m. PST kickoff in Alex G. Spanos Stadium (11,075, natural grass). ESPN Radio (1280 AM) and KCPR (91.3 FM) will carry the first-round postseason game live, beginning with the pregame show at 5:30 p.m. The game also will be available on the Internet via audio and video streams at www.GoPoly.com.
