## 2006 ASI Elections To Be Held May 3 and 4

SAN LUIS OBISPO -- Active campaigning for ASI Elections is just beginning, which means that Cal Poly students will choose their new ASI President and Board of Directors representatives in just over one week. Several events and resources are scheduled to help students make informed decisions about their future leaders.
