## Cal Poly Annual Juried Student Exhibition Opens April 7

SAN LUIS OBISPO -- The best of Cal Poly students' artwork will be featured in a juried exhibition April 7-26 in the University Art Gallery. The title of this year's exhibition is "State Funded."

The public is invited to the free opening reception and awards ceremony from 5 to 7 p.m. Friday, April 7.

Each year students are invited to submit artwork created for any Art and Design Department class to be considered for the Annual Juried Student Show. Work is submitted in five categories: Two-dimensional Studio, Three-dimensional Studio, Graphic Design, Photography, and Freelance.

Local professionals in each field jury the submissions. Cash prizes will be awarded to the jurors' picks for the best work in each category. This year, Cuesta College painting and drawing instructor David Prochaska will jury two-dimensional submissions; Santa Barbara City College sculpture and 3-D foundations instructor Edward Inks will judge

3-D submissions; San Luis Obispo photographer Barry Goyette will look at photography submitted; and Missy Reitner of iiiDESIGN in San Luis Obispo, graphic design entries.

The University Art Gallery, in Room 171 in the Dexter Building, is open 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday through Saturday, and Wednesday evenings 7 to 9.
