Propositions Will Greatly Affect Cal Poly and the CSU

LONG BEACH -- (May 1, 2009) Several important propositions will be before California voters during a special election on May 19th. Propositions 1A - 1E seek to stabilize California's current financial crisis and to implement some long-term budget reform.

During its last meeting, the California State University Board of Trustees voted to endorse Propositions 1A - 1E because of the direct impact they will have on Cal Poly and the CSU if they fail to pass.

Most of the measures provide new revenues to help balance the state's General Fund budget over the next several years. This directly impacts Cal Poly and the CSU, as two-thirds of the CSU budget comes from the state General Fund.
