UPDATE: Cal Poly Swanton Pacific Ranch Threatened as Lockheed Fire Shifts

SAN LUIS OBISPO – Cal Poly's Swanton Pacific Ranch is once again being threatened by the Santa Cruz County Lockheed Fire.

Cal Poly received an update at approximately 1 p.m. from Natural Resource Management Professor Brian Dietterick that the fire shifted and has been moving slowly to the west and onto the ranch.

Staub house, Al Smith house and yurts on the ranch were threatened but Cal Fire firefighters were able to save the buildings.

At last report, the fire is burning slowly behind the School House, which is a residential facility, and across from the Cal Poly Apple Orchard.

Four state staff members and seven student interns remain at the corrals, which are outside the evacuation area. The corrals are still safe and not threatened. The remaining students and staff returned to their homes.
