Cal Poly University Jazz Band To Play Swing Dance Music Jan. 16

SAN LUIS OBISPO -- The public is invited to a dance concert Jan. 16 featuring swing-era tunes played by Cal Poly's University Jazz Band No. 1.

The dance will be from 8 to 11 p.m. in Chumash Auditorium at Cal Poly. Free swing dance lessons will be given at 7 p.m.

The University Jazz Band will perform authentic big-band classics, suitable for dancing or listening, according to director Paul Rinzler.

The band holds swing dances every second Friday of the month from October to May (excluding December and March).

The University Jazz Band has been performing swing dance concerts for years, including a series at the Sacramento Jazz Jubilee, one of the biggest traditional jazz and big-band festivals in the world.
