Guitar Ensembles from Cal Poly and CSU San Bernardino Collaborate

SAN LUIS OBISPO -- The Cal State San Bernardino Guitar Ensemble, directed by Stuart Green, and the Cal Poly Guitar Ensemble, with director Jesús Saiz-Huedo, will gather for two musical weekends of master classes, rehearsals and recitals in March and April.

The first gathering (March 7-8) will be at Cal Poly, and the second (April 18-19) will be at the San Bernardino campus.

"Students of both guitar ensembles have been preparing some common repertoire in order to play together, exchange ideas and learning experiences, and share their love for music," Saiz-Huedo said.

The ensembles will begin rehearsing at Cal Poly on March 7.

On March 8, Saiz-Huedo and Green will conduct a free master class featuring full ensemble, quartet, trio, duo and soloist performances. The master class, which is open to the public, will be from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. in Room 218 of the Davidson Music Center at Cal Poly.

The recital, at 7 p.m. March 8 in Room 218 of the Davidson Music Center, will feature a guitar solo performance by Green during the first half, and the combined guitar ensembles during the second half.

In his solo performance, Green will present his recent world premiere recording of the music of 19th century Spanish guitarist and composer Trinidad Huerta.

Saiz-Huedo will give a solo guitar performance during the first part of the San Bernardino recital, and the combined guitar ensembles will play during the second half. Saiz-Huedo's solo performance will feature a selection of Latin American waltzes for guitar that will include the world premiere of Nostálgico, Mágico and Galante, three new waltzes by Spanish-Argentinean composer Arturo Medina.

At the Cal Poly recital, the joint Cal Poly-Cal State San Bernardino guitar ensembles will perform music by Georg Philipp Telemann, Antonio Vivaldi and Scott Joplin.
