### **Peace Activist, Writer Michael Albert To Speak at Cal Poly Feb. 14**

SAN LUIS OBISPO -- Veteran peace activist, writer and publisher Michael Albert will speak at Cal Poly Feb. 14 and will teach an "activist workshop" on peace organization the following day at the university.

On Feb. 14, Albert will deliver a speech titled "Building an Anti-War Movement That Can Win" at 7 p.m. in Chumash Auditorium. The event will include a question-and-answer session and book signing. The event is free and open to the general public.

Albert is best known for the creation of Z Magazine (<http://www.zmag.org>), which has been described as "an independent political magazine of critical thinking on political, cultural, social and economic life in the United States." Albert is also the creator of ZNET and South End Press.

ZNET is an online forum and information analysis of current news and events, including frequent updates about "to watch" topics ranging from Afghanistan to gay rights.

South End Press is a nonprofit publishing collective with the goal of servicing "readers who are exploring, or are already committed to, the politics of radical social change." Created in 1977, South End has more than 200 titles in print. Frequent contributors include Noam Chomsky, Edward Said, Howard Zinn and others.
