Spend One Enchanted Evening When "South Pacific" Sails Into SLO

SAN LUIS OBISPO, CALIFORNIA – Rodgers & Hammerstein's SOUTH PACIFIC is one of Broadway's most enduring musical theatre classics.

On Wednesday, January 25, 2012 at 7:30 p.m., Cal Poly Arts presents an acclaimed national touring engagement of the lush, musically-rich Rodgers & Hammerstein's SOUTH PACIFIC at the Performing Arts Center's Cohan Center.

This breathtaking new production of SOUTH PACIFIC is based on the 2008 Tony Award-winning Lincoln Center Theater production, directed by Bartlett Sher.
