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Cal Poly Faculty Chamber Recital Set for Oct. 26

This marks the third year of chamber recitals in which faculty join forces to perform masterworks of chamber music – both beloved gems and lesser known works.

After intermission, soprano Katherine Arthur and Davies will perform songs by Hugo Wolf. Davies will then join Paul Severtson, violin, and Shumway for a performance of Ernst Bloch's "Three Nocturnes."

The evening will conclude with two pieces by Jeremy Cohen: "Habanera" and "Tango Eight," performed by Brynn Albanese, violin; and Ken Hustad, bass.
