Prominent Architects to Give Three Talks in October at Cal Poly

SAN LUIS OBISPO — Cal Poly's College of Architecture and Environmental Design has five presentations scheduled for fall quarter as part of its Hearst Lecture Series. The lectures will be held on Fridays in the Business Building Rotunda (Building 3, Room 213).

Three presentations are scheduled for October:

— Ted Hyman, managing partner of ZGF Architects and the principal-in-charge of the new Warren J. Baker Center for Science and Mathematics, will address the firm's most challenging and technologically complex projects. Hyman will talk at 5 p.m.

Oct. 11.

— Dwayne Oyler and Jenny Wu, founding principles of Oyler Wu Collaborative, an architecture practice based in Los Angeles, will explore issues of structural complexity, aggregation, and material research in their work. Their lecture will begin at 5 p.m.

Oct. 18.

— Mathew Chaney and Patricia Rhee, principals of the Los Angeles architecture firm Ehrlich Architects, will discuss the use of advanced technology and innovative delivery methods in their firm's celebrated work. They will present at 4 p.m. Oct. 25.
