SAN LUIS OBISPO — Cal Poly Associated Students Inc. President Jason Colombini won an Undergraduate Award of Distinction from the North-American Interfraternity Conference for outstanding contributions.

Colombini was one of seven undergraduates from throughout the U.S. to win an Award of Distinction, given to acknowledge the hard work of individuals and chapters to improve the Greek experience across the nation.
