

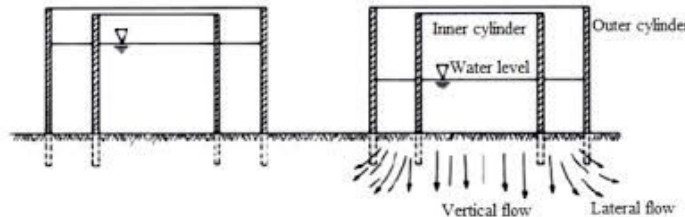
Detention Basin Condition Assessment Forms (DBCFAF)



The state of California requires local cities to perform infrastructure evaluations periodically. One of these evaluations is the assessment of a municipality's stormwater infrastructure. A detention basin is a fundamental part of a city's stormwater infrastructure, typically basins are at the end of the line and catch all the stormwater from reaching natural rivers, lakes, and the ocean. The purpose of a catch basin is to naturally let the water from the previous storm percolate into the ground, replenishing the groundwater. This document will improve the process of evaluating the detention basins and expedite the process. This detention basin condition assessment form or DBCFAF will provide an all in one document for the state of California to use.
