

CITY FARM SLO – WALK-IN PRODUCE COOLER

This project was built for a local non-profit organization in San Luis Obispo called City Farm Slo. The project is a cooler that allows the farm to store produce for an extended period of time and enables them to begin selling to local retailers. The cooler was built inside of a Tuffshed and is refrigerated using both a window air conditioner and a Coolbot device. The project included grading, framing, finish carpentry, painting, roofing, HVAC, electrical, and insulation. The cooler operates at 34 degrees Fahrenheit and cost about \$8,000 in materials.
