

FIRSTFRUITS FARM TRACTOR SHED

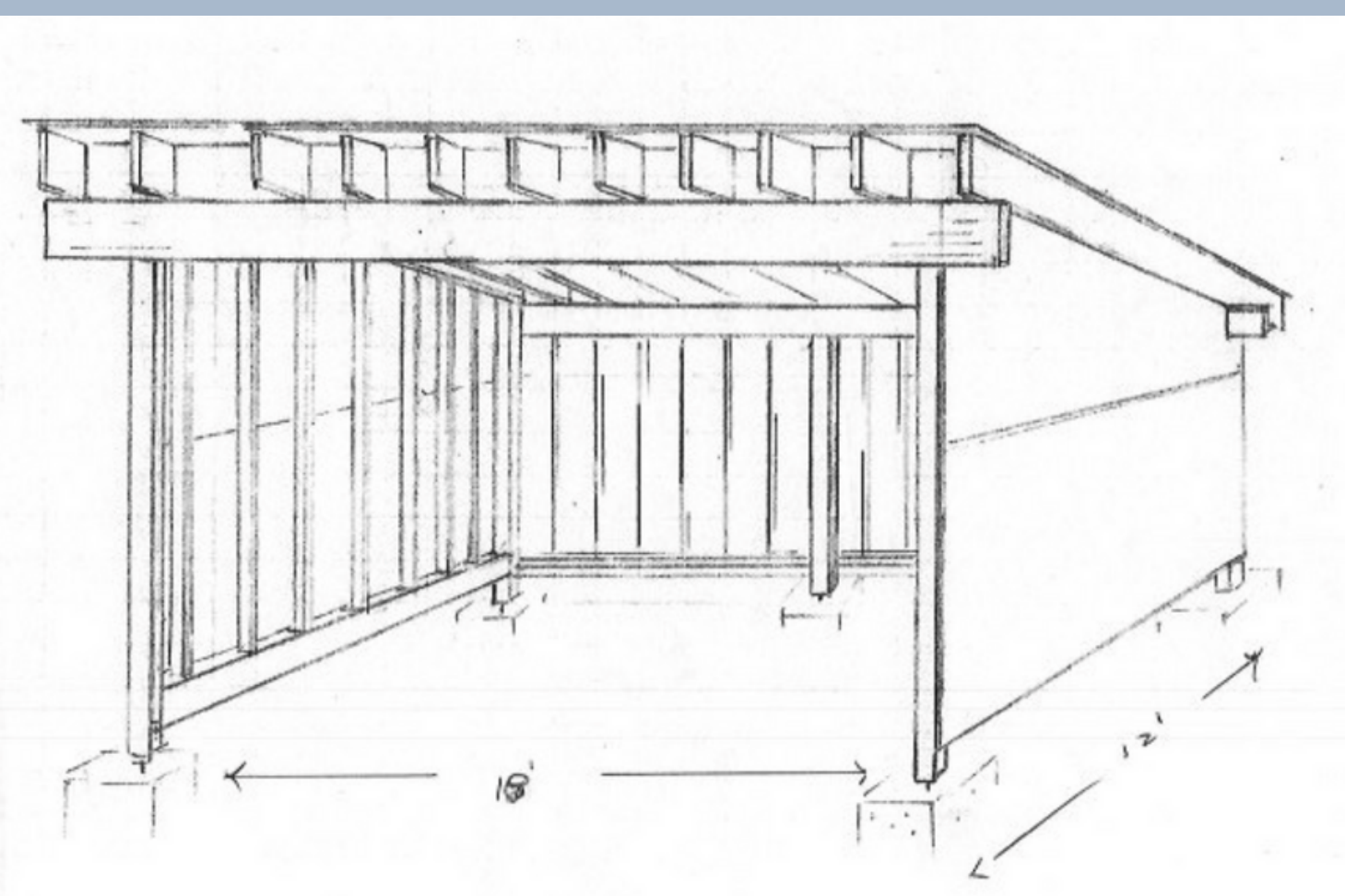
